MUNICIPAL MINI FACTORIES IN KHENANA AREA, WARD 10

The Mandeni Municipality invites bidders from suitably qualified and experienced contractors for the construction of **MUNICIPAL MINI FACTORIES IN KHENANA AREA, WARD 10**. Only Bidders who are registered with CIDB in a contractor grading of **3GB** or higher will be eligible to Bid. In case of Partnership /Joint Venture a consolidated CIDB Registration Certificate meeting these requirements must be attached. Bidders must have proof of CIDB Registration by the closing date failing which their Bid will be disqualified.

The physical address for collection of bid documents is: Mandeni Municipality, Civic Centre, 2 Kingfisher Road, Mandeni (cashiers office) upon presentation of a receipt proving prior payment of a non-refundable fee of **R500.00** (inclusive of VAT), (Cash, Debit Card or EFT: Ref no.: Bid No 33/22/23 Bidder's Name). **Bid documents will be available from 08h00 on Wednesday, 29 March 2023. The cut-off time for selling of bid documents is 15h00 on Tuesday, 11 April 2023.**

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Sibusisiwe Hall, Mandeni on Wednesday, 12th April 2023, starting at 11h00 thereafter proceeding to the site. Failure to attend the compulsory clarification meeting with the bid document will disqualify the tender. The doors to the venue will be closed at 11h00 and no bidder will be permitted to enter afterwards. Bidders that do not bring the document to the briefing will be disqualified.

Bids shall be placed in sealed envelopes, endorsed **"BID NO. 33/22/23: MUNICIPAL MINI FACTORIES IN KHENANA AREA, WARD 10"** and be placed in the Tender Box situated at the reception: Civic Centre, 2 Kingfisher Road, Mandeni, not later than **12h00 (time will ONLY be determined by the Municipal clock at the reception) on Tuesday, 18th April 2023**. Bids are to be submitted on the bid documentation provided by the Municipality. Late submission, electronic or faxed bids will not be accepted.

Only Bidders registered on Central Supplier Database (CSD) will be considered and must provide proof of registration. The following PPPFA Regulations 2022 Specific Goals are applicable for 80/20 evaluation criteria:

The successful bidder will be required to subcontract 15% of the scope to a local contractor.
