REHABILITATION OF QUARTZ ROAD AND A PORTION OF PLATINUM DRIVE IN MANDENI, WARD 4

The Mandeni Municipality invites bidders from suitably qualified and experienced contractors for the **“REHABILITATION OF QUARTZ ROAD AND A PORTION OF PLATINUM DRIVE IN MANDENI, WARD 4”**. Only Bidders who are registered with CIDB in a contractor grading of **7CE or higher** will be eligible to Bid. In case of Partnership /Joint Venture a consolidated CIDB Registration Certificate meeting these requirements must be attached. Bidders must have proof of CIDB Registration by the closing date failing which their Bid will be disqualified.

The physical address for collection of bid documents is Mandeni Municipality, Civic Centre, 2 Kingfisher Road, Mandeni (cashiers office) upon presentation of a receipt proving prior payment of a non-refundable fee of **R600.00** (inclusive of VAT), (Debit Card, Cash or EFT: Ref no.: **Bid No.: 10/26/27 Bidder's Name**). Bid documents can also be emailed to bidders after submission of POP. The Municipal bank details may be requested via email from the Manager SCM. Bid documents will be available from **Wednesday, 23rd September 2026**. The cut-off time for selling of bid documents is **Tuesday, 6th October 2026**

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Tugela Community Hall, Mandeni on Wednesday, 7th October 2026. Thereafter proceeding to the site. Failure to attend the compulsory clarification meeting with the bid document will disqualify the tender. The doors to the venue will be closed at **10h00** and no bidder will be permitted to enter afterwards. Bidders that do not bring the document to the briefing will be disqualified.

Bids shall be placed in sealed envelopes, endorsed **“BID NO.: 10/26/27 - “REHABILITATION OF QUARTZ ROAD AND A PORTION OF PLATINUM DRIVE IN MANDENI, WARD 4”**. And be placed in the Tender Box situated at the reception: Civic Centre, 2 Kingfisher Road, Mandeni, not later than **12h00 (time will ONLY be determined by the Municipal clock at the reception) on Friday, 23 October 2026**. Bids are to be submitted on the bid documentation provided by the Municipality. Late submission, electronic or faxed bids will not be accepted.

Only Bidders registered on Central Supplier Database (CSD) will be considered and must provide proof of registration.

The successful bidder shall be required to Subcontract a minimum of 30% of the scope of works to a Local Contractors within Mandeni Municipality.

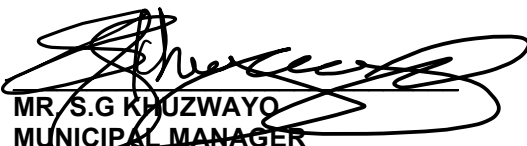

The Mandeni Municipality subscribes to the preferential procurement policy framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and its associated Regulations of 2022. Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the Mandeni Municipality's SCM Policy in one stage. Bids shall be valid for a period of 120 days. The Mandeni Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest bid, either wholly or in part or give any reason for such action. All bidders must provide audited annual financial statements (AFS) for the past 3 years for companies required by law to be audited. For companies not required by law to be audited, AFS for the past three years or since the date of establishment if established during the past three years. All prospective bidders will be screened in accordance with the National Treasury's Defaulters Data Base. Canvassing in any form of gift to Council is strictly prohibited and will lead to the disqualification of the bid.
